It's now 600 years ago that Dordrecht was struck by what was perhaps the greatest flood disaster in the history of the Low Countries: the Saint Elizabeth's Flood. It made the city into an island, which to this day is very vulnerable to flooding. So water safety is clearly of the highest possible priority. Over the past two years, the IABR (International Architecture Biennale Rotterdam) Atelier Dordrecht, under its lead designer Adriaan Geuze (West 8), has investigated how the future need for self-sufficiency in the event of a major flood can be deployed in the search for an answer to the current sustainable area development challenge: How can water safety be used as leverage? The conclusions of the research are presented in the exhibition THE HIGH GROUND.

Bicycle tour to Dordwijkzone City Park

Dordrecht wants to realize 10,000 extra homes without affecting the spatial quality. This presents the challenge of applying smart spatial solutions within the limited space of the existing city. The Dordwijkzone runs from north to south through the city and is currently not optimally designed, fragmented and poorly accessible. This blue-green corridor will play an important role in keeping the city attractive, healthy and resistant to extreme weather. The Dordwijkzone is being transformed into City Park XXL: a valuable city park full of opportunities for nature, recreation and culture. Important features of the transformation into City Park XXL are offering a more varied programme, enhancing the experience of nature and increasing the involvement of residents.
